HB19/SB1452: Drug Importation	OPPOSED	HB passed as of April 11, 2019 SB has not been heard in any committee; SB bills need to pass these committees: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Health Policy (HP) 2. Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and Human Services (AHS) 3. Appropriations (AP)
